The battle of Stalingrad was the most decisive episode of the Second World War. At the cost of huge sacrifices, the Red Army stopped the seemingly invincible Wehrmacht in its tracks. The triumph paved the way for a Soviet counteroffensive on the Eastern Front and the ultimate defeat of nazi Germany.
