The independence struggle in Guinea-Bissau was one of Africa's most symbolic. Led by Panafrikan intellectual Amílcar Cabral, the PAIGC forces went from strength to strength against the Portuguese colonists. Though Cabral was murdered, the country proclaimed its independence on September 24, 1973.
