



On April 25, 1974, a rebellion led by junior military officers brought an end to four decades of fascist dictatorship in Portugal. It was the Carnation Revolution, a peaceful popular and military rebellion that flooded the streets of Lisbon with red carnations and opened a new chapter of democracy and social rights.
