GUNA REVOLT-IN (1925) PANAMA

On February 21, 1925, the indigenous Guna people rebelled against an attempt to eradicate their culture by the Panama government, which intended to install a colonial police force and offer concessions to western banana and mining companies in their territory. Despite the deaths, the Guna triumphed and maintained their autonomy.
