The Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia was proclaimed on November 29, 1945. The nation, which had Josip Broz Tito as its main leader, was forged in the partisan resistance against Nazi occupation. During the following decades, Yugoslavia fostered great economic and social advances internally, as well as international solidarity initiatives.
