Bolivia's history changed for good on December 18, 2005. The Movement Towards Socialism (MAS), led by trade union leader Evo Morales, won the presidency in an act of justice for the indigenous majority. Since then, the Bolivian people have enjoyed great social progress, assuming sovereignty over natural resources. But the threats from the elites persist.
