ARAB REVOLT IN PALESTINE

Zionist expansion in Palestine, backed by British colonialism, sparked a popular uprising in 1936. With labor strikes in cities and acts of resistance in the countryside, the Palestinian people fought for their independence. But the brutal repression from UK forces and Zionist militias smothered the revolt.
